Behaviour chart

In Reception we follow the whole school behaviour policy. We always try to focus on positive behaviour, and reward children for this. Please see the below.

Gold Outstanding!	Consistent silver behaviour (at least 10 silvers) Going 'above and beyond' expectations Being a role model Showing exemplary behaviour every day Being an excellent member of the class
Silver Amazing!	Consistent bronze behaviour Taking risks when learning Constantly challenging yourself Shows resilience by not giving up Showing other children what 'amazing' looks like
Bronze A great day!	Consistent green behaviour Being kind and considerate to others Working especially hard Contributing in all lessons Always doing what is asked
Green Well done 	Listens well Follows school rules Follows routines and instructions Being safe and calm Working hard Wearing the correct uniform
Yellow Think about it	Distracting others from learning Not working to the best of our ability Not following instructions Shouting out in class Not following school rules
Orange Disappointing	Repeated yellow behaviour Calling others unkind names Intentionally damaging property Being disrespectful or rude Leaving class without permission
Red Serious consequence	Repeated orange behaviour (3 oranges) Swearing Hurting others intentionally, verbally or physically Intimidating others Bullying (including cyber bullying) Racism

Behaviour chart

The school's behaviour system revolves around a visible traffic light system within each class. Each child starts the day on green. We use bronze and silver stickers for all children to aspire to. If a child moves their name up on the behaviour chart they will be rewarded with one of these stickers. If a child is consistently moving their name onto silver they will also be considered for one of our special 'gold' awards, these will be used to celebrate those children who are always doing the right thing within school.

Star of the day



Each day we chose a star of the day. This is one child who has particularly shone all day in everything they do! Their picture is then displayed on our special star of the day board. The following day, they sit in the 'star of the day chair' and may also have other special jobs to do.

We use a variety of other positive behaviour management strategies in Reception such as stickers and special jobs.
